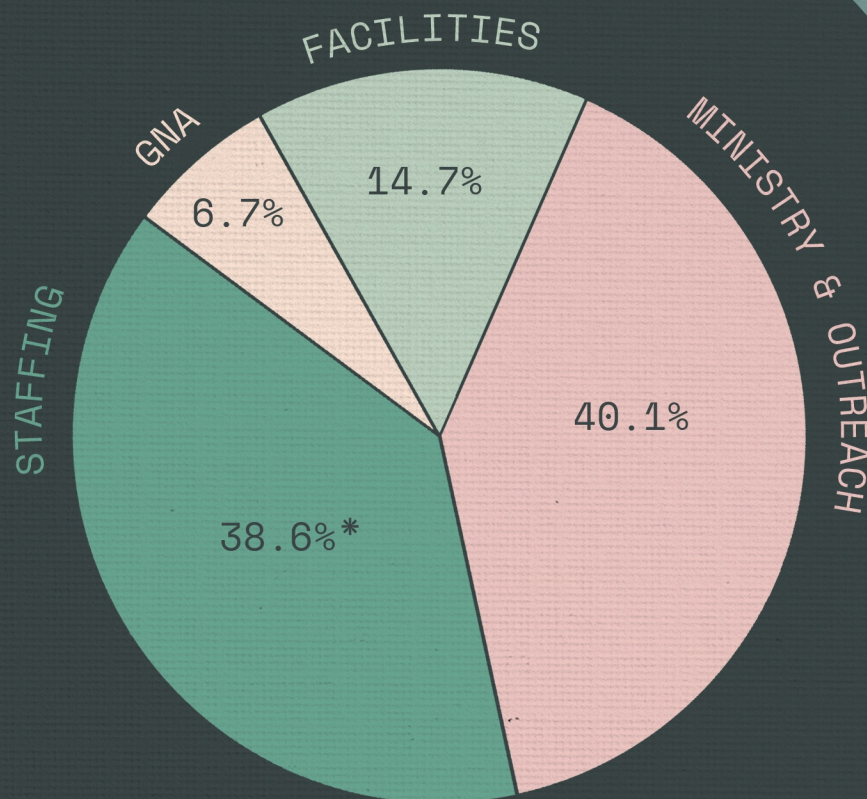

"GREETINGS IN OUR SAVIOUR'S WONDERFUL NAME. WE ARE SO THANKFUL TO YOU ALL FOR YOUR PRAYERS AND SUPPORT FOR OUR MINISTRY. BY THE GRACE OF GOD WE ARE DOING FINE AND GOD IS BLESSING OUR MINISTRY WITH SOME OPEN DOORS IN SOME LEAST REACHED PLACES. THE REPAIR WORK OF THE SCHOOL BUILDING IS PROGRESSING. THE PENDING WORK OF THE COMPOUND WALL GOT COMPLETED. SOME OTHER WORKS LIKE PAINTING AND CHANGING THE ROOF OF THE TOILETS ARE PENDING AS SOME OF THE WORKERS WERE INFECTED BY THE CORONAVIRUS AND WE HAD TO STOP THE WORK FOR SOME TIME. WE WILL START THE WORK AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

IN SOME PLACES ANTI-CHRISTIAN GROUPS ARE TRYING TO ATTACK OUR WORKERS. PERSECUTIONS ARE EVERYWHERE AND CHRISTIAN WORKERS ARE BEING TARGETED BY THE ANTI-CHRISTIAN GROUPS IN INDIA. PRAY FOR OUR SAFETY.

BY THE GRACE OF GOD WE ARE TRYING TO REACH OUT TO THE LOST BY PERSONAL EVANGELISM, CONDUCTING OPEN AIR MEETINGS, AND FORMING SMALL GROUPS. OUR OUTREACH TEAM IS TRYING TO REACH OUT TO SOME OF THE UNREACHED TRIBAL GROUPS. IN THESE PLACES THERE IS NO ELECTRICITY AND OTHER NEEDED RESOURCES SO WE TRY TO HELP THEM WITH RICE AND GROCERIES SO THAT THEY WILL LISTEN TO US. THANK GOD THROUGH THIS MINISTRY MANY HAVE COME TO THE SAVING KNOWLEDGE OF CHRIST."
